## The Bridge Teen Center unveils new addition

The Bridge Teen Center unveiled its new 2,400-square-foot expansion, The Garage, to the public Saturday, May 14 — and it's certainly far from a typical garage.

Priscilla Steinmetz, the center's executive director and co-founder, said the name for the new addition came from where most bands start out: the garage. Live performances will happen on the stage, which has an actual Volkswagen Beetle crashing through the back of it.

"[Co-founder Rob Steinmetz's] dad is a car collector and restores them, so it's in his blood," Priscilla said. "We wanted to create a cool venue for young people. The name, The Garage, makes it a little bit

The new space doubled the size of the teen center, which opened last June. The new space increases the occupancy from 49 people to more than 175.

The expansion was built by volunteers, and construction materials were donated. Home Depot in Orland Park provided a \$15,000 grant to cover the costs. Michael Lunford of Lunford Construction was the volunteer general contractor on the project.

Rob Steinmetz estimated attendance to be a couple of hundred people between a ribbon cutting for key volunteers and donors on Friday, May 13, and Saturday's open house.

"We hope to have 400 to 500 people
